Riverton School District completed the “School Assessment for Determining Grades Under the ABR for the 2019-20 School Year”. The self-assessment is intended to help us evaluate our efforts in the implementation of the Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights. It serves as an opportunity for Riverton School to reinforce and strengthen our HIB prevention and intervention strategies, policies and practices. It also allows us to reflect on areas to improve. In addition to completing the required self-assessment, the School Safety Committee has met regularly to assess and reflect on current issues, strategies and programs. Through the input gathered, modifications, improvements and changes have been implemented.

Results of the self-assessment reveal our district’s continued strength in following all mandated timelines, procedures and initiatives. In addition, Riverton School District continued to implement evidence-based character education programs which target improving school climate and anti-bullying objectives. We continue to utilize the School Safety/Climate Team to gather input from community members regarding student needs and parent workshop topics of interest.

During the 2019-20 school year, Riverton School District continued to implement The Choose Love Program in second grade classes throughout the year. In addition, Week of Respect activities and class lessons, Stars Program, Mindful Minutes and counseling services are available for all students.

The results of the self-assessment yielded the score of 70/78. Riverton School continues to follow all mandated HIB requirements.
