RIVERTON BOARD OF EDUCATION MINUTES OF APRIL 28, 2020 REGULAR MEETING

The regular meeting of the Riverton Board of Education was called to order by Mr. Croft at 7:02 p.m. in the Media Center at the school.

PUBLIC BUDGET HEARING:

Mr. Croft opened the public hearing at 7:05 p.m. and Mrs. Eck presented the 2020-21 budget.

Mrs. Eck reported on: Increased Aid, Tax Levy Adjustment Due to Enrollment, Current & Proposed Programs Mr.Vrettos reported on: Capital Projects & Their Impact on the Budget and the Comparison Between Current & Last Year's Budgets. Mr. Vrettos touched briefly on the one question that came from the public in regards to the advertised percentage increase. He explained how the use of the capital reserve is backed out of the formula in order to determine a budget increase based on the tax payers' income and grants.
