BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing be held at the Riverton Board of Education located at 600 Fifth Street, Riverton NJ 08077 on April 29, 2025 at 6:30 P.M. for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on said budget for the FY 2025-26 School Year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, to include in the tentative budget an adjustment for increased costs of health benefits in the amount of \$54,175, principally to pay for additional increases in benefit premiums for the FY 2025-26 School Year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the tentative budget includes an adjustment for banked cap in the amount of \$90,461 for the FY 2025-26 School Year, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.1(b) for the purpose of maintaining a thorough and efficient education in the district. As statutorily required, the district affirms that it (a) has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority in the budget year; (b) such stated need/purpose will be utilized by June 30,2026; (c) and such stated need/purpose cannot be deferred or incrementally completed over a long period of time.
